

Hi Liana

Further to our last meeting, please find attached detailed budget as per our planned schedule of events... happy to report coming in under your per head allowance.

As discussed with Rick, I have based figures on 45 pax... all adjustable up or down once we have final numbers. I have factored in all service charges & govt taxes where necessary plus expected tips allowances for drivers, restaurants, waiters, etc, along the way. Apart from local Tuk Tuk's from a nearby contact in Patong, I have arranged all transport with Avista sub contractors direct so as to ensure reliability of service.

As per your suggestion, I have included a set consumption based drinks allowance at each restaurant which can be adjusted on the night. The final dinner menu at Baan Rim Pa is as per your request. I have allowed for an additional boat to be on standby depending on numbers This will be a great help in ferrying people to shore for beach cocktails at Ko Naka Yai, then again for lunch at Ko Rang Yai plus give us much better comfort levels in terms of passenger space. Both boats will offer open bar with beer, wine, champagne, soft drinks, water & tropical fruit platters. I have allowed for 2 beach cocktails per person at Naka Yai Island... Pina Colada served in a fresh coconut & Maitai served in a whole fresh pineapple, both featuring a very good local rum. A family style tropical lunch of Thai & International courses will be served under trees on the beach at Rang Yai... arguably one of Phuket's best island swimming beaches. Drinks have not been allowed for here at this stage as we will have plenty onboard. The seafood frenzy at Rawai Seafood Market will include prawns, shellfish, crab, squid, whole fish, etc, plus an International Thai menu will be available. When transferring the group to & from hotel, restaurants & nightlife around Patong, I have arranged a team of local Tuk Tuk's to provide this service with small diversions through nightlife & shopping areas. A team of luxury 10 seater vans from Avista will take us further afield as required..

For guest free time, I have arranged an optional shopping day we can offer the ladies in 3 private cars hosted by the office girls from Royal Phuket Marina... they will pick up from Avista in the morning, head out on a scenic drive to the top of Phuket's highest mountain to Big Buddah, where the ladies can experience a magnificent working Buddhist temple, jungle monkeys & sample the world's best coconut ice cream while taking in 360deg views of Phuket Island. Then on the way down, drop into a roadside elephant kraal for a photo opportunity feeding the kraal's very friendly pet baby elephant. Then on to Phuket Central for the afternoon... home of high end brand shopping in Phuket. That will cost each guest 1000THB (around \$30-\$40 depending on exchange rate) paid directly to the girls.

And for the gents we can offer Phuket's Red Mountain golf course, about 30 mins from the Avista. Rick is planning to come up to join me a couple of days early... we can finalise that then. Patong beach offers all the tourist shopping, parasailing, jet skis, etc, nearby Kata beach offers the same but far more upmarket, plus of course, there is the Avista itself to be enjoyed.

I think we have the makings of a memorable trip outside the realm of normal tourist activity with the advantage of some money-can't-buy experiences in the mix!
